The 2d Reconnaissance Battalion Association is a non-profit organization that exists to support 2d Recon Battalion members (both current and former), while fostering, maintaining and promoting the tradition and well-being of the 2d Reconnaissance Battalion. This includes any Sailor or Marine who has served with the Battalion including:

- Active duty personnel currently assigned to the 2d Reconnaissance Bn.
- Active duty personnel who are currently elsewhere assigned,
- Military retirees who were assigned to the Bn. for all or part of their service (including both Marines and Navy personnel)
- All other Marines and Sailors who served with the Bn. and have since been honorably discharged or separated

The Association is awarding up to **five scholarships** in the amount of: 1 x \$1,000 and 4 x \$500 each to five eligible undergraduate students who will enroll full-or part-time in a university, college, community college, or a VA approved, post-secondary career training school, within the United States in the 2017-2018 school year. Scholarship funds are awarded to offset the expense of tuition/registration, textbooks and materials, and/or room and board for the recipients.

Eligibility: In order to be eligible for the 2d Reconnaissance Battalion Association scholarship, applicants must meet **all** of the following criteria:

- A dependent (child or spouse) of an active duty 2d Recon Marine or Sailor (either living, or one who died while still serving) or dependent of a dues-paying member of the 2d Recon Battalion Association
- Enrolled at least part-time at an accredited university, college, community college, or a VA approved, post-secondary career training school.
- Planning to attend the university, college, community college, or a VA approved, post-secondary career training school in the upcoming academic year
- A maximum family adjusted gross income that does not exceed \$90,000 for the 2016 tax year
- A GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Must be pursuing a bachelor's or associate's degree or technical certificate in the 2017-2018 school year

Required Components of Application Packet:

- Dependents of separated or discharged service members Notarized statement confirming that the applicant has presented documentation of their dependent status
- Active duty dependents Notarized statement confirming that the applicant has presented documentation of their sponsors military service, and also presented their government issued dependent identification card
- Name of Association sponsor with receipt for dues for current year OR name of active duty sponsor and current commanding officer to verify current assignment to the 2d Reconnaissance Bn.
- Copy of 2016 tax return for parent's or guardian of applicant
- Completed 3-page application (must be typed)
- Most recent, sealed, official High school transcript
- Essay of 600-700 words in APA format, in response to the prompt below.
- Letter of acceptance from the intended university, college, community college, or VA approved, post-secondary career training school

The application packet must be submitted to the mailing address above and postmarked no later than July 1, 2017. The scholarship winner will be notified by phone and email by August 1, 2017.

Essay:

Respond to the following prompt in 600-700 words in APA format. Include page number and your full name in the footer of each page. Be sure to spell check your completed essay before submission.

The principles of the United States Marine Corps Recon Battalions are honor, perseverance, spirit and heart. In an essay of 600-700 words in APA format, explain how you have used one or more of these principles to overcome a challenge or obstacle in your life. Be sure to include relevant details that show, not tell, how you overcame or are in the process of overcoming the challenge. Please include at least one paragraph that explains why you have applied for this scholarship and how support from the 2d Recon Battalion Association will be used in the next phase of your educational career.
